

## **FIXED (PERMANENT) RETAINERS**

- 1. Fixed retainers are wires that are bonded to the backside of the teeth. The purpose of these wires is to hold the teeth straight.
- 2. With fixed retainers proper oral hygiene and regular visits to your family dentist for cleaning are essential.
- 3. It is important to monitor your retainers regularly. If it becomes loose or breaks contact us immediately to avoid shifting/relapse.
- 4. Maintenance of your fixed retainer is provided for 2 years as part of your original fee. After 2 years a nominal fee will be charged for repairs or replacements.
- 5. Whenever these retainers are removed there is a chance that some tooth movement may occur; therefore, we recommend leaving these retainers in for as long as possible.
- 6. There's not a set amount of time that a permanent retainer will last some people have worn the retainers for up to 20 years. And in most cases, there aren't any negative long-term effects. But in some cases, the retainer can get worn down so much that it needs to be replaced.
